

Import movements

Approved identifier (upon arrival into Canada).

In most cases this will be an individual ID ear tag, but could include foreign identifiers if they are approved by the Canadian government.

Export movements


SMALL EAR TAG Exported piglets and feeder pigs EXPORT 12345 *(U.S. REQUIREMENT)

Lost tags

If a pig loses an approved ear tag, the person who owns or has possession of the animal must apply a new ear tag at its destination, unless it is an abattoir for slaughter.

Illegal tag application

It is illegal to identify pigs with tags approved for other species, and vice-versa.
